Multidimensional Approach

Key Words

2

- The most specific aspect of a question is the key word used in it such as discuss, examine, critically analyse etc.
- Every key word needs to be understood to know the precise approach as per the demands of the question.
- Language of the question must be read minutely to understand the specific demands.

Data substantiation

- Every answer must contain substantial facts and figures to avoid any ambiguity.
- Analytical language should be made lucid with objectivity with the supplement of such facts.

- Always think how few marks can be increased, work for each mark and for each leftover thing in answer and topic marks will gradually start increasing.

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
